Glasgow HHH Commie (Commonwealth) Hash Weekend

18 – 20 July 2014



In 2014 Glasgow will host the 20th Commonwealth Games and coincidentally GH3 will host the 2014 *Commie* hash event.

It is traditional that every four years there is a Commie weekend and it traditionally is hosted – coincidentally – by the pack nearby the Commonwealth Games.

Whilst this weekend is a stand alone event it is being held a week before the Brussels Beer Odyssey making it one of the major pre – rambles to the big European party next year.

The Glasgow event will be held on the weekend of 18 – 20 July 2014 and be centred on the city with trails taking place out of town.

The event is still being designed but with Glasgow being the gateway to the Scottish Highlands some scenic runs are planned.

Glasgow is Scotland's largest city and has excellent transport links to the rest of the UK and Europe. There are three international airports within an hour of the city and 2 main lines rail links to the south and London.

This level of competition means that [trains](#) and [planes](#) to London (for example) can be got from £30 (\$45). This includes overnight [sleeper](#) trains which are Government subsidised.

The London [pre-ramble](#) to Brussels falls on the Wednesday following the Glasgow event. The *Eurostar* option the next day to Brussels gets you there for the Red Dress Run that day being set by the original San Diego hares!

All this makes Glasgow an ideal starting point for those wanting to train across northern Europe.
